Demonstration by Dennis Daudelin—Stamp Holder

In addition to the information provided here, check www.woodturningonline.com for 2 other designs for stamp holders. This design is made in 3 sections so the tube/mid-section can have the slot cut on a bandsaw without cutting the top or bottom.

Tenon for middle section
